The Swansea-Manchester Trunk Road (Rhiw Bridge Diversion) Order 1977

and

The Swansea-Manchester Trunk Road (Rhiw Bridge Diversion Side Roads) Order 1977

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road at Rhiw Bridge near Berriew in the County of Powys, he has made under the Highways Act 1959

1. An Order under Section 7 which provides:—

- (a) that a road about 285 metres in length which he proposes to construct as a diversion to the existing bridge over the River Rhiw in the County of Powys shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into operation and
- (b) that part of the length of the Swansea-Manchester Trunk Road to be superseded by the construction of the road shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which notice is given by him to the County Council of Powys that the new trunk road is open for through traffic.

2. An Order under Section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 authorising him

- (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise later the Cart Road Footway No. 122;
- (b) to stop up parts of the superseded trunk road and part of the Cart Road Footway No. 122 from its junction with the trunk road;
- (c) to construct new highways to connect the Cart Road Footway No. 122 and the unclassified road to Berriew with the new trunk road;
- (d) to stop up private means of access to premises known as Glansevern Hall and Lodge, Pen-y-Geulan and Dollas; and
- (e) to provide new means of access to premises known as Glansevern Hall, Pen-y-Geulan, Dollas, Vaynor Park and Gro Cottage and the property owned by the Montgomery County Recreation Association from the new trunk road,

all at Rhiw Bridge aforesaid and to provide for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Powys as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.
