HAMPSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1967

The Hampshire (Hawley Lane, A327 and Farnborough Road A325) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order, 1977

Notice is hereby given that Hampshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 74 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967"), and of all other powers then enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84C (1) of the Act of 1967 and subject to the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport under section 84B of the Act of 1967 the effect of which will be to impose a 40 m.p.h. speed limit on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

A copy of the proposed Order and a plan showing the lengths of road in question, together with a copy of the statement of reasons for making the Order, may be inspected at the office of the Borough Secretary, Rushmoor Borough Council, Town Hall, Farnborough and at the office of the undersigned during usual office hours.

SCHEDULE

1. That length of the Farnborough-Reading Road (A327) which extends from a point 170 metres south-east of its junction with Oakfield Road at Hawley in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Farnborough Road (A325) at Farnborough, a total distance of approximately 2,570 metres.

2. That length of Farnborough Road (A325) at Farnborough which extends from a point 67 metres south of its junction with the Farnborough-Reading Road (A.327) in a northerly direction to the county boundary, a total distance of approximately 400 metres. (560)

HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The County of Hereford and Worcester (High Street and Astwood Lane, Feckenham) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977.

Notice is hereby given that on 10th June 1977 the County Council of Hereford and Worcester made an Order under section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting, at any time, of vehicles in the following sides of lengths of High Street and Astwood Lane, Feckenham:—

- (a) that length of the northern/western side of the road from the boundary between Nos. 13 and 15 Astwood Lane to the northern boundary of Feckenham Vicarage, High Street; a distance of 326 metres (356 yards);
- (b) that length of the southern/eastern side of the road from opposite the eastern edge of Swansbrook Lane to

the southern boundary of No. 56 High Street, Feckenham; a distance of 360 metres (394 yards).

The Order shall come into operation on 21st June 1977. Waiting by vehicles of the under-mentioned classes or for the undermentioned purposes are exempted from the provisions of the Order:

1. To enable person to board or alight;
2. To enable goods to be loaded and unloaded;
3. Vehicles in use by the Post Office;
4. To enable certain essential works to be carried out or in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
5. To obtain certain services from a garage;
6. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying a badge issued under the Local Authority's Orange Badge Scheme. (562)

HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The County of Hereford and Worcester (Edward Street, Redditch) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that on 10th June 1977, the County Council of Hereford and Worcester made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive on the west side of Edward Street, Redditch from a point 15 metres (49 feet) north of its junction with Bromsgrove Road to a point 15 metres (49 feet) south of its junction with Bridge Street, a distance of 167 metres (549 feet).

The Order shall come into operation on 21st June 1977.

Waiting by vehicles of the undermentioned classes or for the undermentioned purposes are exempted from the provisions of the Order:

1. To enable persons to board or alight;
2. To enable goods to be loaded or unloaded;
3. To enable certain essential works to be carried out or in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
4. Vehicles in use by the Post Office;
5. For the collection or delivery of furniture or effects;
6. To obtain certain services from a garage;
7. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying a badge issued under the Local Authority's Orange Badge Scheme.

A copy of the Order as made and a copy of the relevant map can be inspected at the Shirehall, Worcester between 9.30 a.m.-12.30 p.m. and 2 p.m.-4.30 p.m. from Monday to Friday inclusive.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act, or any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order is made (such date stated in this notice) make application for the purpose to the High Court.

HOVE BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Hove Borough Council (Stapley Road) (Prohibition of Commercial Vehicles of Over 3 Tons) Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that Hove Borough Council as agents for East Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2), (3), (3AA) and (6) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended.

The Order will prohibit any commercial vehicle having an unladen weight of over 3 tons from proceeding in that length of Stapley Road between its junctions with Hangleton Road and Godwin Road and will revoke the Borough of Hove (Stapley Road) (Prohibition of Commercial vehicles of over 3 tons) Order 1976.

Vehicles will be exempted from the weight restriction in certain circumstances including the following:

- (a) When conveying goods to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that length of road.
