Whereas We consider it desirable that Monday, the second day of January and Monday, the first day of May in the year 1978 should be bank holidays in England, Wales and Northern Ireland and that Tuesday, the twenty-seventh day of December in the year 1977 and Monday, the twenty-inth day of May in the year 1978 should be bank holidays in Scotland:

We, therefore, in pursuance of section 1 (3) of the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971, do hereby appoint Monday, the second day of January and Monday, the first day of May in the year 1978 to be bank holidays in England, Wales and Northern Ireland and Tuesday, the twenty-seventh day of December in the year 1977 and Monday, the twenty-ninth day of May in the year 1978 to be bank holidays in Scotland.
