The usual exceptions have also been provided in the Order for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge. A copy of the Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of the Meirionnydd District Council, Penarlag, Dolgellau during a period of 6 weeks from 6th September 1977.
