AMENDMENTS TO VOLUMES I, II AND III OF THE EUROPEAN PHARMACOPŒIA

The Ministers, that is to say the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health in England and in Wales, the Secretary of State concerned with health and agriculture in Scotland, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland and the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, hereby declare under section 65(8) of the Medicines Act 1968 ("the Act") that the Amendments to Volume I, to Volume II and to Volume III of the European Pharmacopœia contained in the Supplement to Volume III of the European Pharmacopœia have effect for the purposes of the said section 65. The Ministers, being of the opinion that it is necessary for the purpose of giving effect to the Convention referred to in section 65(7) to the Act to publish the said Amendments, hereby, give notice under section 102(5) of the Act that the subject-matter of the said Amendments contained in the said Supplement shall take effect on 1st December 1977.

For the purposes of section 102(6) of the Act, the Ministers acknowledge that copies of the said Amendments included in the said Supplement have been printed and published by Maisonneuve S.A. of Sainte-Ruffine, France, under the direction of the Council of Europe (Partial Agreement).
