THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS 1968, AS AMENDED ROMANIA: OFFICIAL CERTIFICATE

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968 No. 97) as amended by the Imported Food (Amendment) Regulations 1973 (S.I. 1973 No. 1351) he hereby restricts recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in the Schedule to the Notice published in the London Gazette dated 22nd July 1966 for the importation of meat and meat products from Romania to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

The Notice published in the London Gazette dated 29th November 1977 is hereby revoked.

THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS 1968, AS AMENDED NORWAY: OFFICIAL CERTIFICATE

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 (SI 1968 No. 97), as amended by the Imported Food (Amendment) Regulations 1973 (SI 1973 No. 1351), hereby restricts recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in the Schedule to the Notice published in the London Gazette dated 9th June 1970 for the importation of meat and meat products from Norway, to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

The Notice published in the London Gazette dated 7th October 1977 is hereby revoked.
