STAFFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Stafford (Deanshill Close, Stafford)
(Experimental Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the Stafford Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the following lengths of Deanshill Close, Stafford for an initial period of 6 months:

- (a) on its north-east side from its junction with Newport Road for a distance of 75 metres in a north-westerly direction;
- (b) on its south-west side from its junction with Newport Road for a distance of 15 metres in a north-westerly direction.

Exceptions will allow waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading, in connection with the maintenance of the roads and services and with the orange badge scheme for disabled drivers.

The Borough of Stafford (Queensville, Stafford) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978

No Waiting at any time Monday-Sunday

(1) Queensville, Stafford—on both sides from its junction with Silkmore Lane for a distance of 70 metres in a north-westerly direction.

The Borough of Stafford (Lichfield Road, Stafford) (Prohibition of Waiting) Loading and Unloading) Order 1978.

No Waiting at any time Monday-Sunday, No Loading/Unloading, 8 a.m.-9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m.-6 p.m. Monday-Saturday.

(1) Lichfield Road, Stafford—on both sides from a point 70 metres north-west of its junction with Riverway to a point 70 metres south-east of its junction with Riverway.

No Waiting 7 a.m.-7 p.m. Monday-Saturday and No Loading/Unloading 8 a.m.-9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m.-6 p.m. Monday-Saturday.

(1) Lichfield Road, Stafford—on both sides from a point 70 metres south-east of its junction with Riverway to its junction with Queensville Avenue.

The Borough of Stafford (Lichfield Road, Stafford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1978

No Waiting at any time

(1) Lichfield Road, Stafford (within the Lichfield Road gyratory)—

(a) on both sides from its junction with the Lichfield Road gyratory for a distance of 58 metres in a southerly direction;

(b) on its north and east sides from its junction with the Lichfield Road gyratory for a distance of 64 metres in a northerly direction;

(c) on its south and west sides from its junction with the Lichfield Road gyratory to a point 7 metres north of its junction with White Lion Street.

Waiting Limited to one hour in any two at any time

(1) Lichfield Road, Stafford (within the Lichfield Road gyratory)—

(a) on its west side from a point 7 metres north of its junction with White Lion Street for a distance of 46 metres in a northerly direction;

(b) on its east side from a point 64 metres north of its junction with the Lichfield Road gyratory for a distance of 60 metres in a northerly direction.

The Borough of Stafford (Bridge Street, Stafford) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1978

No Waiting at any time Monday-Sunday and No Loading/Unloading 8 a.m.-9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m.-6 p.m. Monday-Saturday.

(1) Bridge Street, Stafford—on both sides between its junctions with Newport Road and South Walls/Mill Bank.

The Borough of Stafford (Foregate Street, Stafford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1978

Waiting Limited to 30 minutes in any hour at any time

(1) Foregate Street, Stafford—on its north-east side from a point 42 metres south-east of its junction with County Road for a distance of 22 metres in a south-easterly direction.

No Waiting at any time Monday-Sunday

(1) Foregate Street, Stafford—on its north-east side from a point 42 metres south-east of its junction with County Road to its junction with Browning Street.

(2) Foregate Street, Stafford—on its south-west side between its junctions with County Road and Browning Street.
