*The Cheshire County Council (Parish of Norbury No. 11)
Public Path Diversion Order 1978*

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order made on the 22nd March 1978 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or confirmed as an unopposed Order by Cheshire County Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert part of public footpath No. 11 in the Parish of Norbury, Crewe and Nantwich, running from Brook House in a south-easterly direction for approximately 114 metres to a line running from a point 132 metres north-east of Brook House on county road C.532 in a generally south-westerly direction for approximately 108 metres to the existing footpath No. 11 at GR 56644744.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it may be inspected free of charge at the office of the undersigned in Room 255 and at the offices of Crewe and Nantwich DC, Information Office, Civic Hall, Nantwich, during normal office hours.

Any objection or representation concerning the Order may be sent in writing to the undersigned before 1st May 1978 and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Cheshire County Council may instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.

*The County of Devon (Bigbury) (Footpath No. 3) Public
Path Diversion Order 1978*

Notice is hereby given that on 13th March 1978 the Devon County Council confirmed the above-named Order as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public right of way running from the B.3392 to Cot Lane Bigbury to a line between points A and D on the plan annexed to the Order as shown by bold black dashes on the said plan.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the plan contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the South Hams District Council Offices, Follaton House, Plymouth Road, Totnes during normal office hours.

The Order becomes operative as from 20th March 1978 but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may, under Schedule 2 of that Act as applied by Paragraph 5 of Schedule 7 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 31st March 1978, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

Public Path Diversion Order, 1978*

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order made on 15th March 1978, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed, as an unopposed Order, by the Gloucestershire County Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert the public rights of way referred to in Part I of the Schedule hereto to the line described in Part II of the Schedule so as to provide a more commodious path.

If no representations or objections are duly made or if any so made are withdrawn, the Gloucestershire County Council may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State, themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State, any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.

SCHEDULE

PART I

A. That length of the public footpath numbered HBW.21 on the Definitive Map of public rights of way prepared under the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949, leading from Clapton Row, Bourton-on-the-Water to the village of Clapton in a generally south-south-westerly and south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 71 metres from a point at O.S. Grid Ref. SP.16712045 marked "A" on Part A of the map to a point at O.S. Grid Ref. SP.16692040 marked "B" on Part A of the map.

B. That public footpath leading from the junction of Clapton Row with Gas Works Lane at O.S. Grid Ref. SP.16722045 marked "C" on Part A of the map and extending for a distance of 22 metres in a generally south-westerly direction to its junction with the public footpath numbered HBW.1 aforesaid at a point at O.S. Grid Ref. SP.16712043 marked "D" on Part A of the map.
