2. The effect of the Order will be:

- (a) to prohibit the right turn by vehicular traffic from Linden Gardens into Notting Hill Gate;
- (b) to compel the right turn by vehicular traffic from the carriageway on the east side of the southernmost island site at the junction of Kensington Church Street and Notting Hill Gate into Notting Hill Gate;
- (c) to compel the left turn by vehicular traffic from the carriageway on the west side of the island site referred to above into Notting Hill Gate.

3. Exemption has been provided in the Order in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.

4. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 24th April 1978, can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made in Room B.21, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB.

5. Copies of the Order may be purchased from the Information Centre, Greater London Council, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB.

6. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, or on the ground that any requirement of that section of the Act or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
