WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

EMPLOYMENT PROTECTION ACT 1975

Linen and Cotton Handkerchief and Household Goods and Linen Piece Goods Wages Council (Great Britain)

The Linen and Cotton Handkerchief and Household Goods and Linen Piece Goods Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of proposals for (1) varying the statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Wages (Linen and Cotton Handkerchief etc.) Order 1977 (Order HL(89)); (2) amending the provisions relating to holidays and holiday remuneration set out in the Wages (Linen and Cotton Handkerchief etc.) (Holidays) Order 1977 (Order HL(90)); and (3) the revocation of Order HL(89) and Order HL(90).

The Wages Council intends that the revised provisions shall come into operation on 6th June 1978.

Particulars of the proposals are contained in the Wages Council's Notices HL(91) and HL(92), copies of which may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below. The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the proposals if made within 14 days from 12th May 1978. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of lengths of Wythes Road and Drew Road, Silvertown, E.16, to enable public open space development to be carried out by Newham London Borough Council under Part III of the said Act.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 212 of the above Act entitled "The Conversion of Highways into Footpaths or Bridleways (London Borough of Newham) (No. 2) Order 1978" extinguishing any right which persons may have to use vehicles (other than those specified in Schedule 2 to the Order) on a length of Kennard Street, E.16 and requiring an improvement of Kennard Street by widening.

Any person who, at the time of the coming into force of the Order, has an interest in land having lawful access to a highway to which the Order relates shall be entitled to be compensated by the Newham London Borough Council as the local planning authority in respect of any depreciation in the value of his interest which is directly attributable to the Order and of any loss or damage which is so attributable.
