TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping Up of Highways (London Borough of Wandsworth) (No. 2) Order 1978" authorising the stopping up of a length of Rawcester Close, S.W.18.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the Wandsworth London Borough Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on a length of the carriageway of Bramford Road, S.W.18.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of that highway by vehicles being used:

- for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;
- on behalf of a statutory undertaker, the Thames Water Authority or the Post Office and engaged upon the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal of any main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878 under, in, on, over, along or across the highway or any land adjacent to the highway;
- in the service of British Rail when being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties in relation to the railway undertaking.
