CLEAN AIR ACT 1956 AND 1968

The Suspension of the North Tyneside Smoke Control Orders Nos. 2 and 3, 1977

Notice is hereby given that on 23rd June 1977 the North Tyneside Metropolitan Borough Council in exercise of their powers enferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 made Orders entitled "The North Tyneside Smoke Control Orders Nos. 2 and 3/1977" declaring the areas mentioned therein to be Smoke Control Areas which said Orders were confirmed without modification by the Secretary of State for the Environment on 26th October 1977.

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of North Tyneside in exercise of their powers conferred on them by section 11 (5) of the Clean Air Act 1956 and section 9 (4) of the Clean Air Act 1968 have resolved to suspend "The North Tyneside Smoke Control Orders Nos. 2 and 3/1977" which were to have come into operation on 1st July 1978.

This means that the operation of section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 (which relates to Smoke Control Areas) and of sections 9 (1) and (2) of the Clean Air Act 1968 (which relate to the acquisition and sale of fuel in Smoke Control Areas) shall be suspended until 1st July 1979.

The areas affected by the above-mentioned suspension are described in Schedules 1 and 2 below:

SCHEDULE 1

The North Tyneside Smoke Control Area No. 2

An area in Wallsend bounded on the north by the bridle road from Rising Sun Farm westward to Station Road, on the west by the centre of Station Road, on the south by the centre of the Coast Road (A.1058) and on the east by the stream behind High View North to the boundary fence north of Rising Sun Cottages thence eastward to Kings Road and the centre of the Farm Road to Rising Sun Farm.

SCHEDULE 2

The North Tyneside Smoke Control Area No. 3

An area in Wallsend bounded on the north by the centre of Whitley Road (A.191), on the west by the main east railway line, on the south by the centre of the Coast Road carriageway (A.1058) and on the east by Station Road North (A.186).

BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Blackpool (Charnley Road) (Two-Way Traffic and "No Waiting") Experimental Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the Blackpool Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972, propose to make the above Order to be operative in the first instance for a period not exceeding 6 months.

The effect of the Order if made would be to:

- (1) permit a two-way traffic flow in Charnley Road for the whole of its length (in lieu of the existing one-way (west to east) flow), and
- (2) prohibit waiting at all times on the north side of Charnley Road from a point 23 metres east of Coronation Street to 9 metres west of South King Street (in lieu of the existing limited waiting restriction).

BLAENAU GWENT BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Blaenau Gwent (Well Street and George Street, Brynmawr) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1978

The Borough of Blaenau Gwent (Bus Pull-in at Ebbw Vale Comprehensive School) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1978.

- (c) no person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in the bus pull-in with Cemetery Road so as to proceed in a westerly direction along Cemetery Road.
