TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971 AND MINERAL WORKINGS ACT 1951

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the Town and he has made an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and section 32 of the Mineral Workings Act 1951 to authorise the temporary stopping up, for a period not exceeding eight years, of that length of highway described in the Schedule to this Notice, to enable open-cast coal working to be carried out by the National Coal Board in accordance with planning permission deemed to be granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.

The Order requires the restoration of the said length of road at the expiration of the period of closure.

Any persons aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the above-mentioned Acts or that any requirement of those Acts or of any regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the 26th June 1978 apply to the High Court for suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
