NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A COMBINED LICENCE TO OBSTRUCT OR IMPEDE THE FLOW OF AN INLAND WATER BY MEANS OF IMPOUNDING WORKS AND TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Anglian Water Authority, Essex Rivers Division, by Fontenay Orchards Limited, for a combined licence to obstruct or impede the flow of a tributary of the River Blackwater by means of catchworks at Grid Reference T.L. 827116, Wickham Bishops Parish, Maldon District, and to abstract 4.7 cubic metres per hour, 113 cubic metres per day, 13,600 cubic metres per year from the said inland water at or near that point.

The capacity of the reservoir at overflow level will be 18,000 cubic metres.

CARLISLE CITY COUNCIL

The City of Carlisle (Lismore Place and Victoria Place) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Carlisle acting as agents for Cumbria County Council, the highway authority, intend to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the east side of Lismore Place from its junction with Victoria Place for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction and on its west side for a distance of 30 metres in a northerly direction from the junction, and on the north side of Victoria Place from its junction with Lismore Place for a distance 35 metres in a westerly direction and in an easterly direction for a distance of 25 metres.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods and where necessary in connection with
- (c) the maintenance of the roads, and
- (d) the supply of gas, electricity and water.

Copies of the proposed Order and map showing the length of road concerned may be inspected at the office of the Clerk and Chief Executive, Civic Centre, Carlisle, during normal office hours.

CARLISLE CITY COUNCIL

City of Carlisle (General Traffic Control) (Amendment) Order, 1978

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Carlisle, acting as agents for Cumbria County Council, the highway authority, intend to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended, the effect of which will be to amend the City of Carlisle (General Traffic Control) Order 1972 by:

- (1) Extending the area of no parking the whole of 24 hours of every day on the west side of Market Street from its junction with Fisher Street to the north of the vehicular access to No. 5 Fisher Street;
- (2) The establishment of a taxi rank with spaces for two hackney carriages on the west side of Market Street in substitution for two disc parking places close to West Tower Street.

CHESTER CITY COUNCIL

City of Chester (City Centre) (Experimental) Traffic Order, 1978

Notice is hereby given that on 28th September 1978, the Council of the City of Chester, pursuant to arrangements made under the Local Government Act 1972 with Cheshire County Council, made an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

This Order which makes it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday on the following lengths of road:

- (i) *Watergate Street*—south side—from a point 30 metres west of the west side of Bridge Street to a point 10 metres east of the centre line of Trinity Street.
- (ii) *Bridge Street*—west side
 - (a) from a point 30 metres north of the north side of White Friars to a point 10 metres south of the centre line of Commonhall Street;
 - (b) from a point 6 metres north of the centre line of Commonhall Street to a point 30 metres south of the south side of Watergate Street.
- (iii) *Northgate Street*—west side—from a point 25 metres north of its junction with Eastgate Street for a distance of 75 metres in a northerly direction.
- (iv) *Market Square*—west side—from a point 30 metres south of the south side of St. Werburgh Street for a distance of 32 metres in a northerly direction.
