

5. After sub-paragraph (b)(ii) of paragraph 3 of the directions the following sub-paragraph shall be added:

"(iii) by the Secretary of State and incurred by him in exercising his functions under the provisions of the Employment Protection Act 1975 (1975 c. 71) relating to maternity pay and in respect of which an amount equal to the amount of such expense is payable out of the Maternity Pay Fund under the provisions of section 124(3) of that Act."

6. Column (1) and column (2) of the Schedules specified in the left hand column of the table to this paragraph shall be amended respectively in accordance with the instructions contained in the middle and right hand columns of the table.

#### Town and Country Planning Act 1971

The length of highway to be stopped up is at Penygraig in the Borough of Rhondda in the County of Mid Glamorgan.

It is a length of Tylacelyn Road which extends from its junction with Cross Street in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 40 yards.
