THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS 1968, AS AMENDED

Netherlands: Official Certificate

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly give notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968 No. 97), as amended by the Imported Food (Amendment) Regulations 1973 (S.I. 1973 No. 1351), and the Transfer of Functions (Wales) (No. 1) Order 1978 (S.I. 1978 No. 272) they hereby restrict recognition of (1) the Official Certificates reproduced in the Schedules to the Notices published in the *London Gazette* dated 15th March 1938 and 19th January 1965 for the importation from the Netherlands of meat products and bacon and (2) the Official Certificate reproduced in the Schedule
