DROUGHT ACT 1976

WATER SHORTAGE

Notice of Application for Emergency Order relating to abstractions from the Newlyn River at Stable Hobba

Whereas in view of an exceptional shortage of rain, a serious deficiency of supplies is threatened in the area of the South West Water Authority (hereinafter called "the Authority") which is served from the Drift Reservoir in the Parishes of Medron, Sancreed and Paul in the District of Penwith.

Notice is hereby given that in order to maintain an adequate supply of water the Authority is applying to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Order pursuant to section 1 (3) (a) and 3 (4) of the Drought Act 1976 to enable it for a period not exceeding 6 months to abstract water by means of an intake to be constructed on the Newlyn River at Stable Hobba at National Grid Reference SW 454293 at a rate not exceeding 1.82 thousand cubic metres (0.4 million gallons) in any twenty-four hours.

This power will be limited to the extent that the residual flow at a point immediately downstream of the intake shall not be reduced below 0.45 thousand cubic metres (0.1 million gallons) in any twenty-four hours.

A copy of a statement and plan illustrating the Authority's proposals may be inspected by any person free of charge at all reasonable office hours at the office of the undersigned and at the offices of the South West Water Authority, Gloweth, Truro and the offices of Penwith District Council, Municipal Offices, St. Clare, Penzance.

Objections to the application may be made to the Secretary of State for the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 3EB (with a copy to the undersigned please) within seven days of the publication of this notice.

Where it appears to the Secretary of State that the Order is required to be made urgently if it is to enable the Authority effectively to meet the deficiency of supplies of water referred to above, he may direct that the holding of a Public Local Inquiry or a hearing by a person appointed by him shall be dispensed with.
