

SOUTH RIBBLE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Borough Council of South Ribble (Kings Croft, Walton-le-Dale) (Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1978

Notice is hereby given that on 3rd November 1978, South Ribble Borough Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974 the effect of which is to prohibit the driving of motor vehicles in Kings Croft, Walton-le-Dale unless the vehicle is being used:

- (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods and merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the road;
- (b) for the purposes of agriculture or in connection with building operations in or adjacent to the road;
- (c) in connection with any work being carried out by statutory undertakers in or adjacent to the road.

A copy of the Order and the relevant map may be inspected during normal office hours at the Civic Centre, West Paddock, Leyland and any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instruments made under it have not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks from 18th November 1978, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
