RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS FROM THE NATIONAL LOANS FUND

NOTICE

The Treasury in pursuance of section 5 of the National Loans Act 1968 hereby give notice that on or after 16th December 1978:

I. Different rates of interest shall apply according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.), or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);

II. The lowest rates of interest satisfying the conditions laid down in subsection (2) of the said section 5 shall be—

The Trunk Road (Northern Avenue and Coryton Interchange, Cardiff) (Prohibition of Foot Passengers) Order 1978.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, which will come into operation on 18th December 1978. The effect of the Order is that no foot passenger shall proceed in those lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

In this Notice:

"the trunk road" means the Cardiff-Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470);

"carriageways" means those parts of the trunk road not forming part of the Coryton Interchange, known as Northern Avenue, used primarily by vehicular traffic, and includes the central reservation but does not include any footpath or footway; and

"Coryton Interchange" means the interchange at Coryton, Cardiff, in the County of South Glamorgan, consisting of the roads forming the roundabout and the four roads joining the roundabout with the carriageways, but does not include any footpath or footway.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to allow a foot passenger to proceed in the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Notice in any of the following circumstances:

(1) where he does so in accordance with any permission given by a police constable and for the purpose of investigating any accident which has occurred on or near the said lengths of the trunk road;

(2) where it is necessary for him to do so to avoid or prevent an accident or to obtain or give help required as the result of any accident or emergency, and he does so in such a manner as to cause as little danger or inconvenience as possible to other traffic on the said lengths of the trunk road;

(3) where he does so in the exercise of his duty as a police constable or as a member of a fire brigade or of an ambulance service;

(4) where it is necessary for him to do so as the result of a vehicle stopping in any of the said lengths of the trunk road by reason of a breakdown or other defect or it being prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside the control of the driver;

(5) where it is necessary for him to do so in order to recover or move any object which has fallen in any of the said lengths of the trunk road;

(6) where it is necessary for him to do so in order to carry out in an efficient manner:

(a) the maintenance, repair, cleaning, clearance, alteration or improvement of any part of the said lengths of the trunk road;

(b) the removal of any vehicle from any part of the said lengths of the trunk road; or

(c) the erection, laying, placing, maintenance, testing, alteration, repair or removal of any structure, works or apparatus in, on, under, over or abutting any part of the said lengths of the trunk road; or

(7) where it is necessary for him to do so in connection with any inspection, survey, investigation or census which relates to the said lengths of the trunk road or any part thereof and which is carried out in accordance with any general or special authority granted by the Secretary of State.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of the South Glamorgan County Council, County Headquarters, Newport Road, Cardiff, during a period of 6 weeks from 15th December 1978.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks of 4th December 1978 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULE

(i) that length of the carriageways which extends from a point 40 yards south-east of the centre line of the overbridge carrying the roundabout at the Coryton Interchange over the carriageways to a point 490 yards south-east of the centre line of the said overbridge, a total distance of approximately 450 yards; and

(ii) the Coryton Interchange.
