#### WATER RESOURCES ACT 1963

Notice of Application for Licences to Obstruct or Impede the Flow of an Inland Water by means of Impounding Works and also to Abstract Water

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Severn-Trent Water Authority by W. D. Porter and Company, Evesbach Court, Bishops Frome, Worcester.

Details of the first licence is to obstruct or impede the flow of an unnamed tributary of the River Leadon by means of a rolled earth embankment and excavation at NGR SO 688 478. The object of impounding water by means of the works is to form a fishing and amenity lake. The capacity of the reservoir at overflow level will be 850,000 gallons. Details of the second licence is to abstract the following

quantities of water from an unnamed tributary of the

River Leadon at the following point of abstraction NGR SO 689 480, 300,000 gallons per day, 60 million gallons per annum. Further details of the application are that the water will be used to initially fill and then circulate through a fishing and amenity lake. All water after initial filling to be returned to the River Leadon.

A copy of the applications and of any map, plan or other document submitted with these may be inspected free of charge at Evesbach Court, Bishops Frome, Worcester at all reasonable hours during the period beginning on 8th January, 1979 and ending on 5th February 1979.
