The Trunk Road (Various Roads, Kettering) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 on lengths of the London-Inverness Trunk Road (A6) and the Oxford-Market Deeping Trunk Road (A43) at Kettering in the County of Northampton-

The effect of the Order, which comes into operation on 16th January 1979 is to:

(i) prohibit waiting by vehicles at any time on any day in the lengths of road or on either of the sides of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice, and
(ii) prohibit waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the side of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

Exceptions have been provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to angel from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein, the collection or delivery of postal packets, and for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes. Exceptions have also been provided for disabled person's badge holders.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provisions contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers with respect to the Order conferred by the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of, or of any instrument made under, any

provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of 5th January 1979 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of

apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

Northampton Road (A43/A6), from a point 110 metres west of the centre of its junction with Northfield Avenue (A6 trunk road section) to its junction with Sheep Street.

Northfield Avenue (A6), from its junction with the northern side of Northampton Road to a point 62 metres north of that junction.

Sheep Street (A6), from its junction with the northern side of Northampton Road to its junction with the southern side of Bowling Green Road.

Bowling Green Road (A6), north side, from its junction with Sheep Street to its junction with London Road.

Bowling Green Road (A6), south side, from its junction with Sheep Street to its junction with Bowling Green Avenue.

Bowling Green Road (A6), south side, from its junction with London Road to a point 25 metres west of that junction.

London Road (A6), from the north side of its junction with Bowling Green Road to a point 52 metres south of its junction with St. Mary's Road.

No waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday

Bowling Green Road (A6), south side, from its junction with Bowling Green Avenue to a point 25 metres west of its junction with London Road.
