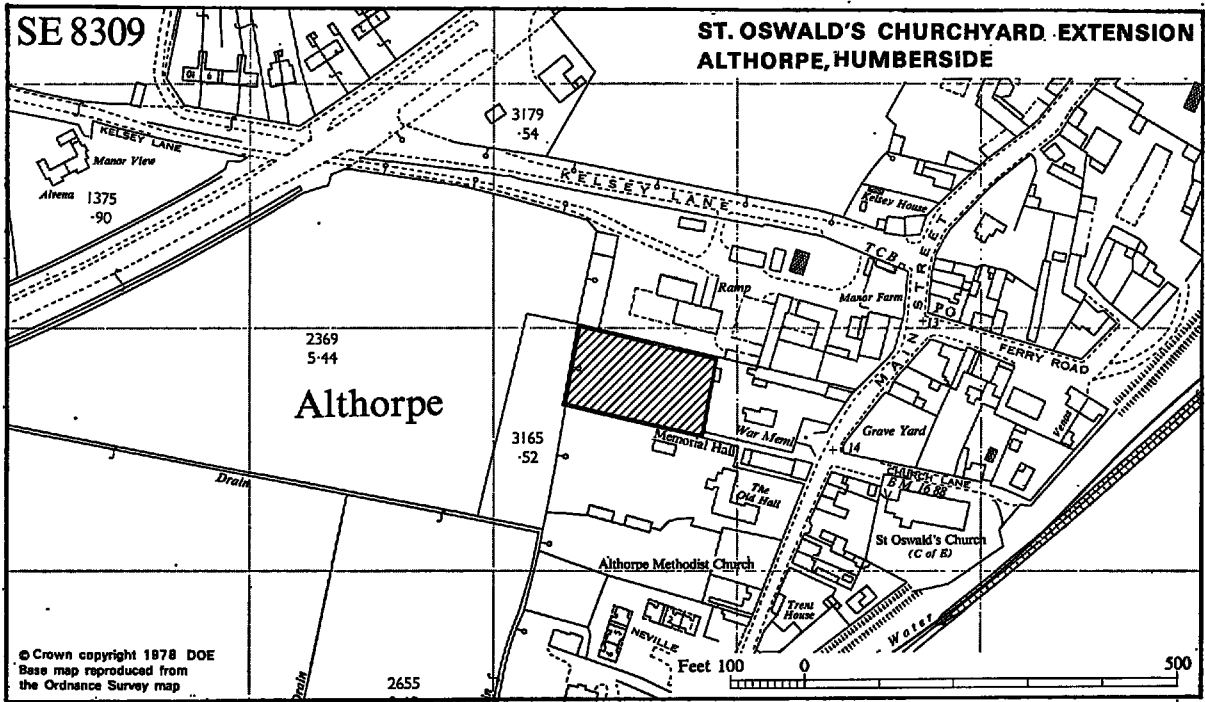


The Plan referred to in the foregoing Order in Council



At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 6th day of February 1979

PRESENT,

The QUEEN'S Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

Whereas a Representation duly made to Her Majesty in Council by the Secretary of State for the Environment that burials should be discontinued as hereinafter directed in St. John the Baptist's Churchyard, Chapeltown, in the City of Sheffield, has, in pursuance of an Order in Council made the 15th day of November 1978, and duly published, been taken into consideration by a Committee of the Privy Council:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 1 of the Burial Act 1853 c. 134 and of all other powers Her enabling is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. Burials shall be discontinued forthwith and entirely in St. John the Baptist's Churchyard, Chapeltown, in the City of Sheffield, which is shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto.
2. This Order may be cited as the Burial Grounds (St. John the Baptist's Churchyard, Chapeltown, Sheffield) Order 1979.
