 - (a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the lengths of street specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
 - (b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place will be prohibited between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the lengths of street referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above;
 - (c) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle in the lengths of street referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above will be prohibited, except on a Sunday, unless the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected: effected;
 - (d) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, in the lengths of street referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above will be prohibited.
 - (e) any existing prohibitions on waiting by vehicles, on the sale of goods and on advertising activities in the length of street specified in Schedule 2 to this notice imposed by the Sutton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1976 will be revoked.
