Notice is hereby given that on 9th February 1979 the Secretary of State for the Environment confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to extinguish the public right of way running from its junction with Latteridge Lane approximately 34 metres north of Poplar Farm in a north-westerly direction for approximately 580 metres to its junction with Latteridge Lane.

The Order becomes operative on 9th March 1979 but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order he may, under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 7 of the Act, within 6 weeks from 23rd February 1979, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1959—SECTION 111*The West Oxfordshire District Council (Footpaths Nos. 1, 2 and 4 Filkins) Public Path Diversion Order No. 1/1978*

Notice is hereby given that on 14th February 1979 the West Oxfordshire District Council confirmed the above-mentioned Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert that section of:

- (i) Footpath No. 2 which at present runs from the south-east corner diagonally to the north-west corner of O.S. Field No. 15; and
- (ii) Footpath No. 1 which at present runs from the south-east corner in a north-westerly direction to a point approximately 160 metres from the north-western corner of O.S. Field No. 15; both now to follow the southern perimeter of O.S. Field No. 15 in a westerly direction and thence at the south-western corner of the said field veering northwards following the whole length of the western perimeter of the said field; and to divert that section of Footpath No. 4 which at present runs from the south-western corner diagonally to a point approximately 50 metres from the north-eastern corner of O.S. Field No. 15, to follow the whole length of the western perimeter of the said field in a northerly direction.

The diversion will become operative on such date as it is certified by the District Council that works required by the Order to be carried out to the replacement path, have been so carried out to the Council's reasonable satisfaction.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the offices of the West Oxfordshire District Council, Woodgreen, Witney and may be inspected free of charge, between the hours of 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1968*The Borough Council of Pendle (Public Footpath No. 208, Colne) Public Path Diversion Order 1979*

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order made on 21st February 1979, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed as an unopposed Order by the Borough Council of Pendle.
