Whereas the Secretary of State for the Environment, after giving to the Incumbent and Churchwardens of the Parish of St. John Baptist, Hythe, in the County of Hampshire, ten days' previous notice of his intention in that behalf, has, under the provisions of the Burial Act 1853 as amended by subsequent enactments, made a Representation to Her Majesty in Council that burials should be discontinued forthwith in Hythe (St. John Baptist) Extension Burial Ground, Dibden, in the said Parish, shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto:


Provided that in the said Extension Burial Ground, in the one reserved grave space in which no interment has heretofore taken place, the burial may be allowed of the body of the person for whom such grave space has been reserved and appropriated as a burial place, with the exclusive right of burial therein, subject to the condition that no part of the coffin containing the body shall be at a depth less than three feet below the level of the surface of the ground

adjoining the grave: Now, therefore, Her Majesty in Council is pleased hereby to give notice of such Representation and to order that the same be taken into consideration by a Committee of the

Privy Council on the 4th day of June next: And Her Majesty is further pleased to direct that this Order be forthwith published in the London Gazette, and that copies thereof be affixed on the doors of the Churches or Chapels of, or on some conspicuous places within, the Parish affected by such Representation one month before the said 4th day of June.

Whereas it is expedient to provide for revised rates and conditions of award of retired pay, pensions, preserved pensions, terminal grants, preserved terminal grants, gratuities, resettlement grants and redundancy payments for Officers, Non-Commissioned Officers and Men of the Royal Name and Royal Marines for mombers of Oueen Alexan Navy and Royal Marines, for members of Queen Alexan-dra's Royal Naval Nursing Service, and for Officers and Ratings of the Women's Royal Naval Service; and of pensions and gratuities to the widows and children of deceased Officers, Petty Officers, Non-Commissioned Officers and Men of the Royal Navy and Royal Marines :

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act 1865 c. 73, and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Non-Effective Benefits and Family Pensions) Order 1979.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1978 c. 30 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

General

3. The revised rates and conditions of award of retired pay, pensions, preserved pensions, terminal grants, preserved terminal grants, gratuites, resettlement grants, product dancy payments in respect of service in the Royal Navy, Royal Marines, Queen Alexandra's Royal Naval Nursing Service and the Women's Royal Naval Service, and of pensions and gratuities to widows and children in respect of the service of deceased Officers, Petty Officers, Non-Commis-sioned Officers and Men of the Royal Navy and Royal Marines shall be as specified in the Schedules annexed hereto.

4. Except as otherwise indicated, the provisions contained in the Schedules to this Order shall have effect from 1st April 1978.
