TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 to authorise the stopping up of the lengths of highway specified in the Schedule to this notice to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of that Act.

Copies of the Order may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the Secretary of State, Welsh Office, Transport and Highways Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff, CF4 5PL (quoting the reference number WR15/52/7) and may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the offices of the Merthyr Tydfil Borough Council, Town Hall, Merthyr Tydfil.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 10th May 1979, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULE

(All distances are approximate)

The lengths of highway to be stopped up are at Dowlais, Merthyr Tydfil in the County of Mid Glamorgan and are:

- Those lengths of Church Street which extends from:
 - its junction with Upper Union Street in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 9 yards.
 - a point 5 yards south-east of its junction with East Street in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 7 yards.
- The whole length of Cross Well Street.
- That length of Well Street which extends from a point 55 yards from its junction with Church Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 106 yards.
- That length of Market Street which extends from its junction with High Street in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 30 yards on its northern side, and 16 yards on its southern side.
- That length of Jones Terrace which extends from a point 3 yards north of its junction with Well Street in a northerly then easterly direction to a point 14 yards north of its junction with High Street.
- That length of road known as Garden Row for its entire length.
- That length of footpath known as Garden Row, for its entire length.
