# ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

#### AVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Avon (Armoury Square, Easton, Bristol) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 10th May 1979 the County Council of Avon made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is:

- (a) to prohibit any vehicle waiting at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice; and
- (b) to restrict any vehicle waiting for a longer period than 2 hours in any 4 hourly period between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Saturday (inclusive) in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

Exemptions in the Order permit vehicles to wait for the purposes of boarding or alighting; goods to be loaded or unloaded; Post Office services; maintenance of the roads; supply of gas, water or electricity; the pursuance of statutory powers or duties; police, fire brigade or ambulance services and in accordance with the current provisions for disabled persons' vehicles.

The Order will come into operation on 22nd May 1979 and a copy thereof together with a map may be inspected at the under-mentioned offices (Sixth Floor) during the hours of 8.30 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Mondays to Thursdays and 8.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. on Fridays.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks after the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
