In the matter of BLOOMSCROL INVESTMENTS LIMITED and in the matter of the Companies Act 1948.

And it is ordered that the Registrar of Companies do advertise this order in his official name in the *London Gazette*

And it is ordered that the petitioners the said Ironlink Limited and Ivor John Grist be jointly and severally liable to pay to the Registrar of Companies his costs of the said petition such costs to be on the High Court Scale and on the Common Fund Basis and to be taxed if not agreed.
