THE NEW TOWN OF REDDITCH

*Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way
 Part of Statutory Footpath No. 66, Winyates Green,
 Redditch*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the New Towns Act 1965 proposes to make an Order extinguishing the public rights of way over the following highways shown coloured red on the map hereinafter referred to:

- (a) part of Footpath No. 66 from a point marked A on the map approximately 170 metres south of the subway crossing the south of the Ravensmere Interchange then running in a north-easterly direction along the southern side of Blacksoils Brook for approximately 70 metres to a point 70 metres east of the footbridge and marked B in the map and then south-east for approximately 290 metres to its junction with Footpath No. 173 at a point marked C on the map.
- (b) part of Footpath No. 66 from the point 70 metres east of the footbridge over Blacksoils Brook and marked B on the map and extending in a north-easterly direction for 70 metres to the north side of Far Moor Lane at a point marked D on the map.

A map showing the rights of way proposed to be extinguished and the alternative routes already provided and to be provided may be inspected at the offices of the Redditch Development Corporation, Holmwood, Plymouth Road, Redditch, and at Alfred Preedy, Unit 10, Winyates Centre, Winyates, Redditch, during normal office hours.
