### EUROPEAN ASSEMBLY ELECTIONS ACT 1978

#### *Declaration of a vacancy in the constituency of London South West*

Whereas Miss Shelagh Roberts was declared to be elected as the Representative in the Assembly of the European Communities for the constituency of London South West at the election polling for which took place on 7th June 1979; and

Whereas at the time of that election the said Miss Roberts was a member of the Occupational Pensions Board and as such would be disqualified for membership of the House of Commons under the House of Commons Disqualification Act 1975; and

Whereas a person is disqualified under paragraph 5 (1) (a) of Schedule 1 to the European Assembly Elections Act 1978 for the office of Representative to the said Assembly if that person is disqualified under the House of Commons Disqualification Act 1975 for membership of the House of Commons, and, under paragraph 5 (4) of the said Schedule 1 the election of any person disqualified under that paragraph is void; and
