## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping Up of Highways (County of West Midlands) (No. 7) Order 1979" authorising the stopping up of a part of George Avenue, Rowley Regis.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 7 weeks of the 3rd August 1979 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the Wrekin District Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles over lengths of Dawley Bank and Old Office Road, Dawley, Telford.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of those highways by vehicles being used:

- (a) for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;
- (b) on behalf of a Statutory undertaker or the Post Office and engaged upon the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal under, in, on, over, along or across the highway of any main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telegraph line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 211 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of two lengths of Eckington Road, Mosborough, Sheffield, in the interests of the safety of users and to facilitate the movement of traffic on the T13 East Grid Road and the T14 North Grid Road which are highways to be constructed in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of that Act.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the Scunthorpe Borough Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on lengths of Porter Street and Frodingham Road, Scunthorpe.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of those highways by vehicles being used:

- (a) for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;
- (b) on behalf of a Statutory undertaker or the Post Office or sewerage authorities and engaged upon the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal of any main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878 or any sewer under, in, on, over, along or across the highway or any land adjacent to the highway;
- (c) a vehicle being used by the local highway authority in pursuance of their Statutory powers and duties.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the Congleton Borough Council he has made an Order entitled "The Conversion of Highways into Footpaths or Bridleways (County of Cheshire) (No. 1) Order 1979" extinguishing any right which persons may have to use vehicles (other than those specified in Schedule 2 to the Order) on John Street, Congleton and requiring an improvement of Egerton Street by the construction of a turning head.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 10th August 1979 apply to the high court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

Any person who, at the time of the coming into force of the Order, has an interest in land having lawful access to a highway to which the Order relates shall be entitled to be compensated by the Congleton Borough Council as the Local Planning Authority in respect of any depreciation in the value of his interest which is directly attributable to the Order and of any other loss or damage which is so attributable.
