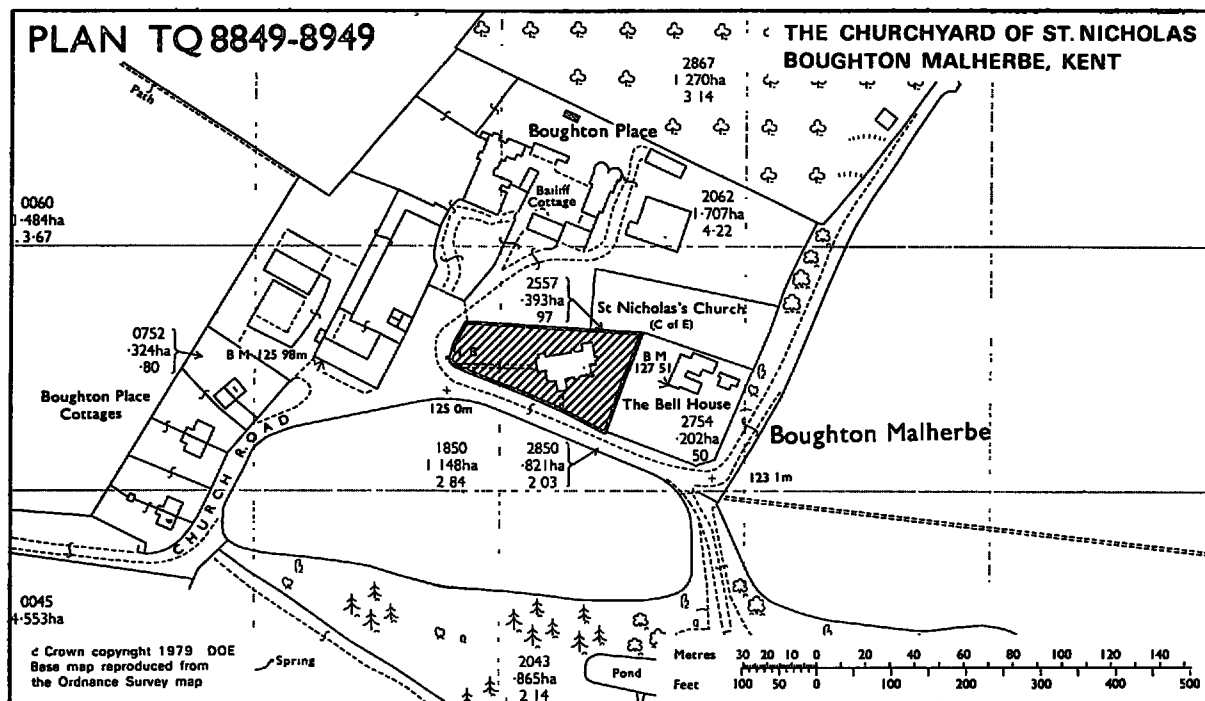

#### *The Trunk Road (Builth Wells, Powys) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales, has made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended which shall come into operation on 13th August 1979. The effect of the Order is to prohibit any vehicle from waiting at any time on the side and lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions have been provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle; to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein; or to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of the local authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

Exceptions are also provided in the Order to allow vehicles bearing both a disabled person's badge and a parking disc to wait in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice for a period not exceeding two hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).

A copy of the Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of Builth Wells Town Council, "Cloverly", Garth Road, Builth Wells, Powys LD2 3AR, for a 6 week period from 9th August 1979.
