The South Yorkshire County Council (Various Roads at Sheffield) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (No.) Order 19 .

Notice is hereby given that the South Yorkshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1963, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the proposed Order will be:

- (i) to prohibit waiting by vehicles at any time in any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- (ii) to prohibit waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive in any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice; and
- (iii) to prohibit waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive for a period of not more than one hour, return prohibited within three hours, in any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice.

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, in connection with building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the mantenance of the roads and the services therein, in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and for the collection and delivery of postal packets. The usual exceptions for disabled persons' vehicles are also included in this Order.

Ecclesall Road (Service Road), both sides, from its junction with Moore Street to a point 111 metres west of the eastern kerb line of Clarence Lane.
