#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 to authorise the stopping up of the length of highway described in the Schedule to this Notice to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of that Act.

Copies of the Order and relevant plan may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the offices of the Newport Borough Council, Civic Centre, Newport and may be obtained free of charge from the Secretary of State, Welsh Office, Transport and Highways Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL quoting reference WR 15/34/14).

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the 3rd September apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

#### SCHEDULE

(all distances are approximate)

The length of highway to be stopped up is at Newport in the County of Gwent. It is that length of Courtybella Terrace which extends from a point 31 yards south east of its junction with Price Street in a south-easterly direction to a point 11 yards north-west of its junction with Lime Street.

#### HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 AND 1971

*The Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (Rhyd-y-Beillen Improvement) Order 1979 and The Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (Rhyd-y-Beillen Improvement Side Roads) Order 1979*

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that in relation to the above mentioned Trunk road at Rhyd-y-Beillen in the County of Dyfed, he has made under the Highways Act 1959

- an order under Section 7 which provides:-
  - that a road about 285 metres in length which he proposes to construct at Rhyd-y-Beillen in the County of Dyfed shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into operation and
  - that the length of the Fishguard-Bangor Trunk Road to be superseded shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which notice is given by him to the County Council of Dyfed that the new Trunk Road is open for through traffic.
- an Order under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 authorising him
  - to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways
  - to stop up highways
  - to construct a new highway to connect the length of the Trunk Road to be superseded with the above-mentioned Trunk Road.

all at Rhyd-y-Beillen aforesaid, and to provide for the transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Dyfed as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.
