2. Exemption will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading goods and in connection with services of statutory undertakers.

Exemptions will also permit disabled person's vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge to wait for periods displaying a disabled person's badge to wait for periods of up to two hours in the lengths and sides of lengths of roads referred to in paragraph 1(a) and (b) above if a parking disc issued by a local authority marking the time at which the period of waiting is displayed. 4. Full details of these proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map relating to the draft Order and statement of reasons may be examined at the Town Hall, West Bromwich, during normal office hours.

- (iii) to prohibit the use of the High Street, Northallerton from its junction with Romanby Road to its junction with Friarage Street by heavy commercial vehicles of over 3 tons unladen weight except for access to load and unload. There is an exemption in the Order for public service vehicles.
