The Trunk Road (Pentre Bach-Dowlais Top) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Clearways) (Wales) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. The Order will come into operation on 10th September 1979. The effect of the Order operation on 10th September 1979. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit (with certain exceptions) the waiting of vehicles in any part of the Pentrebach (Merthyr Tydfi)-Dowlais Top Trunk Road (A4060) between Pentrebach and Dowlais Top, in the county of Mid Glamorgan. The Order will also prohibit trading from the verges and lay-bys of the main carriageways of the length of trunk road.
