The effect of this Order which will come into operation on Monday, 19th November 1979, will be:

(1) To prohibit waiting at any time in the following

lengths of road:

(a) on both sides of Millbrook Point Road from its junction with Millbrook Road southwards for a distance of 65 metres.

(b) on both sides of Third Avenue from the western kerb-line of Millbrook Point Road westwards for a distance of 25 metres.

2) To prohibit waiting 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Friday in the following length of road:

On both sides of Third Avenue, from a point 25 metres west of its junction with Millbrook Point Road westwards for a distance of 135 metres.
