Copies of the maps showing the exact boundaries of the Conservation Areas have been deposited at the District Council Planning Office, Gernon Road, Letchworth, and also at the County Planning Office, County Hall, Hertford, and may be inspected during normal office hours from Monday to Friday inclusive.

THE SCHEDULE

Enlargement of existing Conservation Area in: Codicote

The Conservation Area is extended in the following places:
(i) to include 23 Heath Lane, the rear gardens of 19 and 19A Heath Lane, and the recent residential development at Hall Hill Farm, returning to the existing boundary at the rear of 26 St. Albans Road;

the rear of 26 St. Albans Road;

(ii) to include 29 and 31 High Street, then along the rear boundaries of 8 to 10 Gower Close. It includes the buildings and playing fields of Codicote School, the Vicarage, and then follows the rear boundaries of Nos. 2 to 10 Valley Road returning to the existing boundary at the rear of The George and Dragon Hotel.

Enlargement of Existing Conservation Area in:

The Conservation Area is extended in the following places:

(i) to include the extensive earthworks lying to the northwest of St. Mary's Church, then following the public footpath and field boundaries westwards, and the rear boundaries of 44 and 46 High Street and Hobbing Foot Cottage. It then crosses High Street and Milksey Lane, turning south through the grounds of Graveley House then west along the north side of Oak Lane returning to

the existing boundary at the corner of Turf Lane;

(ii) southwards to include The Waldens, turning eastwards to to meet the existing boundary at the rear of 3 High Street;

(iii) the amended boundary follows the eastern side of High

Street turning eastwards to include 6 and 8 High Street. It then follows the southern boundaries of properties in Church Lane, including the pond at Graveley Bury, then turns south to include the grounds of The Old Rectory.

(iv) to follow the track and property boundaries at Crow End crossing Church Lane to include land to the east of

Cornfields.

Enlargement of existing Conservation Area in: Kimpton

The Conservation Area is extended in the following places:
(i) to follow the field boundary south of Pams Cottage eastwards to the Recreation Ground;

(ii) to include land adjoining Bury Farm to the rear of Nos. 2 and 8 High Street.

The Conservation Area is amended to exclude Nos. 30 to 38 Canham Close, then follows the southern edge of Canham Close turning south to the rear of 44 High Street. Nos. 1 to 3 The Wick are also excluded from the Conservation Area.

Enlargement of existing Conservation Area in:

The Conservation Area is extended in the following places:

(i) along field boundaries to include the network of ponds

and fields to the north of Burge End;

(ii) to include land to the rear of 17 and 19 Royal Oak Lane, it then follows the boundaries of Nos. 10 to 26 Royal Oak Lane and Littlegreen Farm House, meeting the existing boundary between the barns at the rear of 2 Royal Oak Lane:

(iii) to include the Primary School playing fields, then along a public footpath to Shillington Road;

(iv) to include land at the rear of 3 Burge End.

The Conservation Area is amended in the following places:

 from 21 Shillington Road westwards along the southern edge of the road to include 71 Shillington Road, returning to the existing boundary at Rectory Farm;
(ii) to follow the property boundaries of Nos. 6 to 8 Dock-

lands and the rear boundaries of Nos. 22 to 28 Crabtree T ane

(iii) to follow the rear boundary of the Fox. P.H. in High Street, and the front boundaries of Nos. 10 to 14 Cromwell

Enlargement of Existing Conservation Area in St. Ippollitts

The Conservation Area is extended in the east, to the south of Stevenage Road, to include the properties "Gaddesden", "Libet", "Dellview Cottage" and "Hill Rise", returning to the existing boundary along the northern edge of the Stevenage Road.

Enlargement of existing Conservation Area in:

The Conservation Area boundary is extended to follow the eastern boundary of 1 Cambridge Road, the rear boundaries of the property "Shalimar" and Nos. 15 to 36 Picknage Road, returning to the existing boundary along the southern side of No. 36 Picknage Road.

The Conservation Area boundary is amended to follow the western edge of the lane adjacent to the property "Homestall" and is then extended in a northerly direction along the lane, turning eastwards, to the rear of the property "White Posts".

Enlarging of existing Conservation Area in:

The Conservation Area is extended in the following places:

 to include the barn and land to the west of Brickyard Lane and the rear gardens of the Village Hall and Moyailler. It then turns west along Blacksmiths Lane then south to include the cricket ground. The boundary is then amended to follow the rear of Goodfellows Farm running parallel with Church Lane along the rear of Glebe House, returning to the existing boundary north of Church Farm; west of Reed Hall southwards to include land on the west

side of Church Lane, and the earthworks to the south of

Reed Hall;
(iii) eastwards from St. Mary's Church following field boundaries to include the meadows, earthworks and ponds in the south-east corner of the village. It then follows field boundaries to the east of High Street as far as Crow Lane. The boundary is then amended to follow the southern side of Crow Lane, and then the rear boundaries of properties to the north of Crow Lane and Jacksons Lane as far as Brickyard Lane.

Enlarging of existing Conservation Area in: Rushden

The Conservation Area is extended in the following places:

(i) to include the mediaeval earthworks lying to the north of St. Mary's Church;

(ii) along the northern side of the Southern Green Road to include The Bungalow and land to the south of Church

Farm. It then turns south-east to include Rainbow End and the garden of Flint Cottage;

(iii) to include 9 and 10 Hill View them northwards along field boundaries to include wooded land to the rear of Old Thatches and Windmill House. It then includes the garden land of Hillside turning eastwards to include part of a tree belt to the north of Hillside returning to the existing boundary to the west of the village hall.

Enlargement of existing Conservation Areas in: Therfield

The Conservation Area is extended in the following places:

(i) to include Carters Hill and High Beeches, then southwards along the rear boundaries of properties in the Causeway to the Burial Ground;

(ii) to include land adjoining Hay Farm to the north of Nine Elms.

The Conservation Area is amended in the following places:

(i) along the northern edge of Kelshall Road between Tuthill and Carters Hill;

(ii) along the eastern boundary of Hay Farm;

(iii) to follow the southern boundary of The Grange and the western edge of Police Row.

Enlargement of existing Conservation Areas in: Wallington

The Conservation Area is extended in the following places:

- (i) to include the tree belt and enclosed meadows to the north of Kits Lane;
- to follow the western edge of the public footpath from Kits Lane south to Wallington Chase;
- (iii) to include the track and field immediately to the south of Wallington Bury;
- along the eastern edge of the public bridleway from Manor Farm northwards to The Street
- The Conservation Area is amended in the following places: (i) to follow the western side of The Street between 38 and 44
- The Street;
 (ii) to following the public footpath along the western side of Wallington Chase.
