ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

AVON COUNTY COUNCIL

(Moravian Road Area, District of Kingswood) (General Traffic Regulation) Order 19

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Avon propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be:

1. to prohibit any vehicle waiting at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;
2. to prohibit any vehicle waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Saturday (inclusive) in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice;
