HARTLEPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Hartlepool (Turnbull Street Area/Hartlepool)
(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Hartlepool Borough Council, in exercise of Highway Agency Powers conferred on them by Cleveland County Council, made the above Order on 18th February 1980 under the provisions of sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. The Order will come into operation on 20th February 1980.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the following roads and sides of roads in Hartlepool, namely:

Hurworth Street on the southern side of the road from its junction with Turnbull Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 24 metres and then in a northerly direction for a distance of 7.5 metres;

on the northern side of the road from a point 4 metres east of its junction with Raby Road for a distance of 26 metres in an easterly direction and then in a southerly direction for a distance of 7.5 metres.

Perth Street on the northern side of the road from its junction with Turnbull Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 15 metres and then in a southerly direction for a distance of 7.5 metres;

on the southern side of the road from a point 4 metres east of its junction with Raby Road for a distance of 26 metres in an easterly direction and then in a northerly direction for 7.5 metres.

Gray Street on the southern side of the road from its junction with Turnbull Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 39 metres and then in a northerly direction for a distance of 7.5 metres;

on the northern side of the road from a point 2 metres east of its junction with Raby Road for a distance of 30 metres in an easterly direction and then in a southerly direction for a distance of 7.5 metres;

and will prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on the following road and side roads in Hartlepool, namely:

Turnbull Street on the western side of the road from its junction with Brougham Terrace in a southerly direction to its junction with Gray Street.
