ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Isle of Wight (Various Streets, Ventnor/St Lawrence/Bonchurch, IW) (Traffic Regulation) Order No. 1 1980

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Isle of Wight in exercise of their powers under section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police propose to make an order the effect of which will be as follows:

1. To revoke The County Council of Isle of Wight (Various Streets, Ventnor/Wroxall/St Lawrence/Bonchurch, IW) (Traffic Regulation) Order No. 1 1979.
2. To re-enact the provisions contained in the above Order that relate to Ventnor, Bonchurch and St. Lawrence only, subject to the following amendments:
 - (a) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the following lengths of road:
 - Belgrave Road* on south side from Bath Road to 80 feet east thereof;
 - Belgrave Road* on south side from 45 feet east to 100 feet east of Park Avenue;
 - Bonchurch Village Road* on north side from the junction with St Boniface Road to 25 feet east of Madeira Road;
 - High Street* on north side from Tulse Hill to 90 feet east thereof;
 - Madeira Road* on both sides from Bonchurch Village Road to a point 50 feet south-east thereof;
 - St. Boniface Road* on both sides from Trinity Road/Bonchurch Village Road to a point 25 feet west thereof;
 - St. Catherines Street* on south-east side from 220 feet north-east to 240 feet north-east of Wheelers Bay Road;
 - Trinity Road* on both sides from Bonchurch Village Road/St Boniface Road to a point 50 feet south-west thereof;
 - West Street* on east side from 45 feet north of South Street to 45 feet south of North Street;
 - West Street* on east side from 45 feet south of High Street to 45 feet north of North Street;
 - Zig Zag Road* on north side from 50 feet west of Alpine Road to 280 feet north-east of Park Avenue.
 - (b) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Mondays to Fridays in the following length of road:
 - Newport Road* on both sides from 45 feet north to 120 feet south of Downlands Crescent.
 - (c) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. 1st May to 30th September in the following lengths of road:
 - Mitchell Avenue* on north side from 165 feet east of Southgrove Road to 400 feet north of Spring Hill;
 - Ocean View Road* on north side from Gills Cliff Road to 50 feet west of Zig Zag Road;
 - Ocean View Road* on north side from 50 feet east of Zig Zag Road to Old Shute.
 - (d) To revoke the No Waiting At Any Time restrictions in the following lengths of road:
 - South Street* on both sides from East Street to 45 feet south-west thereof;
 - West Street* on west side from 25 feet south to 45 feet south of High Street;
 - West Street* on west side from South Street to 45 feet north thereof.

All restrictions relating to Wroxall will be re-enacted in a separate Order to be known as 'The County Council of Isle of Wight (Various Streets, Wroxall, IW) (Traffic Regulation) Order No. 1980'.

The Order is designed to reduce congestion and delay in the said roads and to facilitate the free flow of traffic generally in the promotion of road safety.

The Order contains exemption clauses to permit the loading and unloading of goods.

A copy of the draft Order, this Notice and the relevant plan Day be inspected between normal office hours at the Reception desk, County Hall, Newport, Isle of Wight during the objection period. Notice is hereby given that the Manchester City Council as agents for the Greater Manchester County Council propose to make Orders under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be:

(a) To prohibit waiting by vehicles at any time and loading or unloading from 8 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays on:

Church Lane,
Harpurhey North-easterly side between a point opposite a point 15 metres north-west of the north-westerly kerb-line of Potters Lane and a point 75 metres south east thereof.

South-westerly side between the south-easterly kerb-line of Norman Road West and a point 23 metres south-east thereof.

Nigel Road

North westerly side from the north easterly kerb-line of Church Lane to a point opposite the south-westerly kerb-line of Springville Avenue.

South-easterly side from the north-easterly kerb-line of Church Lane to a point 34 metres south-west of the south-westerly kerb-line of Springville Avenue.

(b) To prohibit waiting by vehicles and loading or unloading from 8 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays. To limit waiting to one hour in any two from 9.30 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays on:

Church Lane

South-westerly side between the south-easterly kerb-line of Potters Lane and the north-westerly kerb-line of Norman Road West.

Norman Road West

Both sides from the south-westerly kerb-line of Church Lane for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction.

Potters Lane

South-easterly side from the south-westerly kerb-line of Church Lane for a distance of 5 metres in a south-westerly direction.

(c) to prohibit waiting by vehicles at any time on:

Fernclough Road,
Harpurhey South side from Upper Conran Street to parking area adjacent to Norbet Walk.

North side from Upper Conran Street to Nolan Street.
