*Declaration of Nature Reserve
Parishes of Beaulieu and Exbury*

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of section 19 of the above-mentioned Act that by the North Solent Nature Reserve No. 1 Declaration 1980, made on 26th February 1980, the Nature Conservancy Council declared that the land containing 660 hectares (1,631 acres) or thereabouts situate in the Parishes of Beaulieu and Exbury in the county of Hampshire and shown edged red on the plan attached to the said Declaration is the subject of an Agreement entered into with the Council under the provisions of section 16 of the above-mentioned Act and the said land is being managed as a Nature Reserve.

Certified copies of the said Declaration with plan attached have been deposited for public inspection free of charge at the office of the Hampshire County Council at the Castle, Winchester, and the office of the New Forest District Council at Appletree Court, Lyndhurst, from Monday to Friday inclusive during the normal office hours.

THE GAS ACT 1972

The Gas (Declaration of Calorific Value) Regulations 1972

Notice is hereby given, in pursuance of the Act and Regulations above referred to, that on and after 1st April 1980, the British Gas Corporation will supply gas of the new calorific value of 1035 British Thermal Units per cubic foot to consumers in the area comprising the local authority districts or parts thereof referred to in the Schedule hereto. The area to be so supplied is shown delineated by a broken green line and coloured green on a map signed on behalf of the said Corporation and deposited at premises of the said Corporation (where it is open to inspection by any consumer at all reasonable times free of charge) at the Regional Head Office of the South Eastern Region of the Corporation, Segas House, Katharine Street, Croydon CR9 1JU.

This declaration of calorific value shall take effect, for the purpose of calculating the charge to be made for gas supplied to any consumer, immediately after the first reading of that consumer's meter on or after the date on which gas of the said new calorific value is first supplied to that meter.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Blackpool (Victoria Hospital)
(Prohibition of Driving) Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that Blackpool Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Lancashire County Council, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974, propose to make the above Order.

It will have the effect of prohibiting vehicles, other than emergency vehicles, from using the ambulance exit road from Victoria Hospital immediately south of Whippark Avenue and which joins the public highway on East Park Drive.
