THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS 1968,

Brazil: Official Certificate

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly give notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968 No. 97), as amended by The Imported Food (Amendment) Regulations 1973 and 1979 (S.I. 1973 No. 1351 and S.I. 1979 No. 1426) and the Transfer of Functions (Wales) (No. 1) Order 1978 (S.I. 1978 No. 272) they hereby vary the recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in the Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 3rd December 1968 for the importation of meat and meat products from Brazil by extending that recognition to include meat of the description given in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Carcases or portions of carcases comprising recognisable wholesale or retail cuts without bone, which contain no associated lymphatic glands or from which any pleura, peritoneum or lymphatic gland has been removed.
