

Subscriber's responsibility for equipment and apparatus

4. For paragraph 14 of the principal Scheme there shall be substituted the following:

" Subscriber's responsibility for equipment and apparatus

14.—(1) The subscriber shall be responsible for the safe keeping and proper use of any equipment or apparatus (whether or not connected for use or comprising or forming part of an installation) which is placed in the subscriber's premises or put into his possession in consequence of or in connection with an application by the subscriber for telecommunication service.

(2) The subscriber shall pay in respect of the replacement of any such equipment or apparatus which is lost, stolen or destroyed and the replacement or repair of any such equipment or apparatus which is damaged otherwise than by fair wear and tear, such charge as the Post Office may fix.

(3) A subscriber shall not himself do or permit or suffer any other person to do (except a person who is so authorised by the Post Office) the following:

(a) alter an installation or any part of an installation;

(b) move an installation or any part of an installation except an installation or part of an installation which is intended to be moveable by the subscriber;

(c) do anything which is likely to damage or adversely affect the performance of an installation; or

(d) obliterate or deface any words on an installation or part of an installation;

(4) The Post Office may remove the installation within such time as it thinks fit after the cesser or termination of provision of telecommunication service and the subscriber's obligations under the provisions of this paragraph shall continue until the installation has been either removed by the Post Office or provided by the Post Office as a means of telecommunication for another subscriber without being removed."

Charges for Telecommunication service—general

5.—(1) In paragraph 18(8) of the principal Scheme the words " for an installation or a component part of an installation" shall be deleted.

(2) In paragraph 18(10) of the principal Scheme for the words " calls from the installation " (which appear at the end of the words in brackets) there shall be substituted the words " such calls ".

Connection charge

6.—(1) In paragraph 21(1)(a) of the principal Scheme the words " by means of an installation " shall be deleted.

(2) In paragraph 21(3) of the principal Scheme the words " by means of an installation " and the words " in the subscriber's premises " shall be deleted.

Charges for certain inspection or maintenance work

7. For paragraph 29 of the principal Scheme there shall be substituted the following:

" Charges for certain inspection or maintenance work"

29.—(1) If work done by the Post Office (whether work involved in inspecting, testing or otherwise) in response to a complaint of a fault in any equipment or apparatus which the Post Office is responsible for maintaining (whether or not it is an installation) reveals no such fault the subscriber in respect of such equipment or apparatus shall, if the Post Office so requires, pay such charge as the Post Office may fix.

(2) If the subscriber or a person appearing to the Post Office to be acting on his behalf requests the Post Office to carry out work to remedy a fault in any equipment or apparatus which the Post Office is responsible for maintaining (whether or not it is an installation) outside such hours as the Post Office may from time to time determine to be normal working hours, and the Post Office accedes to such request, the subscriber shall pay in respect of any work done outside such hours as aforesaid in remedying or attempting to remedy the fault such charge as the Post Office may fix.

(3) If the subscriber requests the Post Office to provide maintenance service in respect of any equipment or apparatus which the Post Office is responsible for maintaining (whether or not it is an installation) which will entail greater expense to the Post Office than the maintenance service which it would normally provide in respect of such equipment or apparatus, and the Post Office accedes to such request, the subscriber shall pay in respect of providing such maintenance services."

Additional particulars of calls

8. For paragraph 33(3) of the principal scheme (as amended) there shall be substituted the following:

" (3) The subscriber shall pay (except where the Post Office determines that no charge shall be payable) in respect of the supply of additional particulars such charge as the Post Office may fix either generally or in relation to the particular case (not exceeding the appropriate maximum charge specified in item 4 of Schedule 18 in a case where such a charge is specified)."

9. Private attachments to the subscriber's installation

In paragraph 38 of the principal Scheme (as amended) sub-paragraph (6) shall be deleted.

10. For item 2 of Part 2 of Schedule 5 to the principal Scheme there shall be substituted the following:
