Public Path Extinguishment Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that on 21st April 1980 the Stroud District Council made the above-named Order which is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the Stroud District Council as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order if confirmed without modification will be to extinguish that length of Public Footpath ST.67 Lightpill, Stroud running from the junction with Bath Road (A46) between the properties known as 1 Kitesnest Lane and 257 Bath Road, and over the land occupied by the Hillclose Estate to the position at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SO.84172/03865, approximately 166 metres in an east by south-east direction; a satisfactory alternative route having been provided by the adopted highway system.

If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent to the Secretary of State with the Order.
