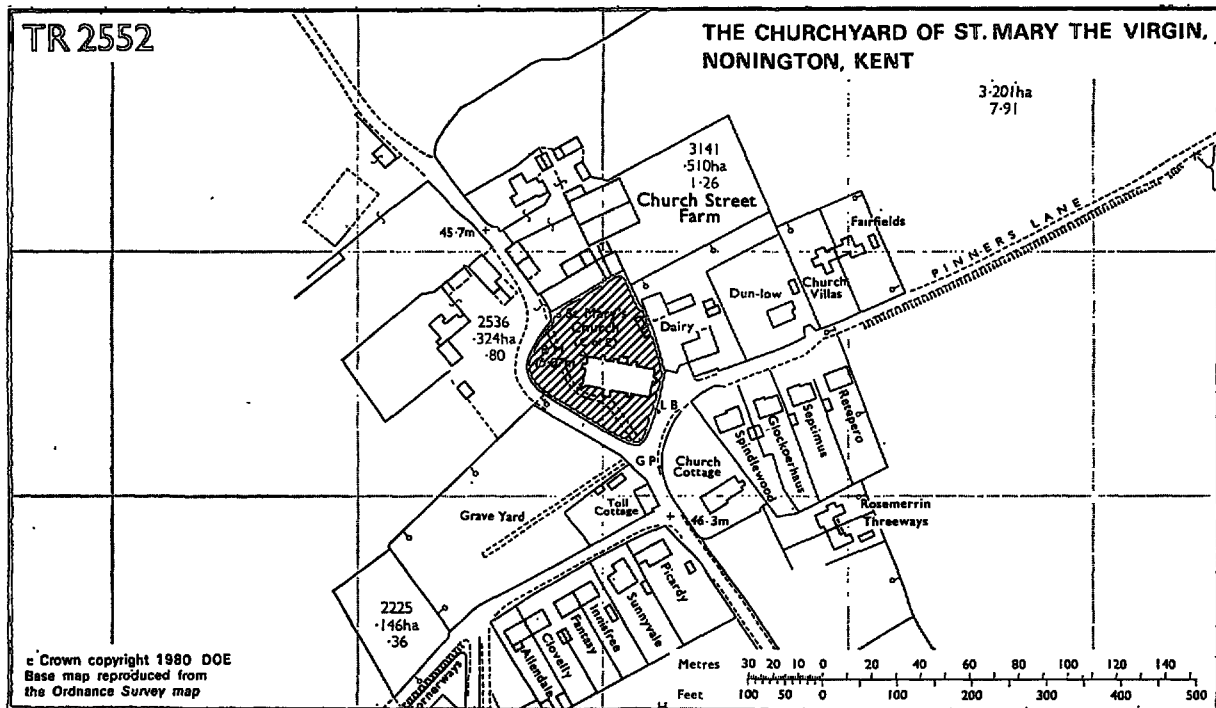

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Rule 5(2)(c) of the Restrictive Practices Court Rules 1976 that on 24th April 1980 there was issued out of the Restrictive Practices Court (in England and Wales) by the Director General of Fair Trading pursuant to section 1(3) of the Restrictive Trade Practices Act 1976 a Notice of Reference referring the above-mentioned Agreements being numbered S.16 and S.487 in the Register of Agreements maintained under section 1(2) of the said Act

And Notice is hereby further given that pursuant to Rule 5(1) of the said Rules the said Director General has nominated:

(1) The Society of West End Theatres of Bedford Chambers, Covent Garden, London W.C.2 as Representative Respondent to represent (for the purpose of all proceedings in the above matters) all parties to the said Agreements on or after the 22nd March 1976 (save, in respect of Agreement No. S.487, those parties represented by the Combined Theatre Libraries Association), and

(2) The Combined Theatre Libraries Association of c/o Keith Prowse, 24 Stove Street, London W.C.1 as Representative Respondent to represent (for the purpose of all proceedings in the above matters) all parties to the said Agreement numbered S.487 on or after the 22nd March 1976 not being members of the Society of West End Theatres.

If either the Society of West End Theatres or the Combined Theatre Libraries Association objects to being made Representative Respondent or any party to the said Agreements objects to being represented by the said Society or by the said Association they may, pursuant to Rule 6 of the said Rules apply by notice in writing within twenty-eight days of the publication of this Notice to the Restrictive Practices Court, Royal Court of Justice, Strand, London W.C.2 for an order revoking or modifying the nominations and for such other directions as may be specified in any such application.
