Notice is hereby given that the Greater Manchester County Council propose to make an Order under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part 1X of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Act 1974, in connection with the Princess Road/Barlow Moor Road major improvement scheme. The effect of the pro-posed Order would be:

(a) To prohibit all vehicles other than buses and cycles from proceeding in the near side lane of the following lengths of Princess Road:

Princess Road, north bound carriageway from a point 142 metres south of the southerly kerb-line of Barlow Moor Road to a point 109 metres south of that kerb-line of Barlow Moor Road to a point 109 metres south of that kerb-line; and

Princess Road, north bound carriageway from a point 83 metres south of the southerly kerb-line of Barlow Moor Road to Barlow Moor Road.

Exemptions in the draft Order permit vehicles to enter the bus lanes for the purposes of boarding or alighting, building operations or work on or under the lengths of road.

(b) To prohibit the left-hand turn from the north bound carriageway of Princess Road into Barlow Moor Road.(c) To prohibit the right-hand turn from the south bound

carriageway of Princess Road into the West to South Slip Road which connects Barlow Moor Road to the north bound carriageway of Princess Road.

(d) To cause vehicles to proceed in the directions specified below:

Vehicles to proceed in a south bound direction only or on the south bound carriageway of Princess Road at its junction with the bus terminal exit;

Vehicles to proceed in a north bound direction only on the north bound carriageway of Princess Road at its junction with the West to South Slip Road from Barlow Moor Road;

Vehicles to proceed in a south bound direction only from the West to South Slip Road from Barlow Moor Road into the south bound carriageway of Princess. Road

Vehicles to proceed in an east bound direction only on Barlow Moor Road at its junction with the north bound carriageway of Princess Road;

Vehicles to proceed in a west bound direction only on Barlow Moor Road at its junction with the south bound carriageway of Princess Road; and Vehicles proceeding on the South to West Slip Road from Princess Road to Barlow Moor Road to turn left only into Barlow Moor Road.

(e) To impose one way working on:

The egress from the southern arm of Mersey Crescent between the proposed service road and Princess Road in that direction;
