The Order becomes operative as from 21st May 1980, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any regulation made there-under has not been complied with in relation to the con-firmation of the Order, he may under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 7 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 9th May 1980 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
