

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Buckinghamshire County Council (A413 High Street, Wendover) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1978.

Notice is hereby given that on 7th May 1980 the Buckinghamshire County Council made the above-named Order under sections 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order, which will come into operation on 19th May 1980, is to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day for more than one hour return prohibited within one hour in that length of the south-east side of High Street commencing from a point opposite the south-western boundary of number 29 High Street and continuing to a point 36.5 metres south-west of its junction with the access to the car park and library.

Exemptions to the Order will permit:

1. Waiting with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden.
2. Waiting for so long as may be necessary: (a) for persons to board or alight; (b) for goods to be loaded or unloaded; (c) for enabling works to be carried out; (d) in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; and
3. The waiting of Disabled Persons' vehicles in accordance with the "Orange Badge" scheme.

A copy of the Order together with a map showing the lengths of road concerned may be examined at: County Hall, Aylesbury and at Wendover Library, High Street, Wendover, during normal opening hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, (as amended), or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 7th May 1980, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

CAMBRIDGE CITY COUNCIL

The City of Cambridge (Great Eastern Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that Cambridge City Council acting in pursuance of arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Cambridgeshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974 made the above Order on 12th May 1980 the effect of which is to prohibit all vehicles from waiting between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday only on the west side of Great Eastern Street from a point 45 feet north of its junction with Mill Road for the remainder of its length.

The Order comes into force on 19th May 1980 and a copy may be inspected free of charge during normal working hours at the Guildhall (Room 6, First Floor).

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirements of that section or of sections 84(A), 84(B) or 84(C) of the Act or any regulation made under the said section 84(C) have not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made make application for the purpose to the High Court.

CAMBRIDGESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Cambridgeshire (High Street, Sawston) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that the Cambridgeshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 84(D) (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on the side of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The Order will contain exemptions to allow a vehicle to wait for as long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded; to enable a person to board or alight; to enable it to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition and the maintenance of essential services and to allow a disabled person's vehicle to wait for up to two hours.

A copy of the proposed Order, a map showing the road to which it relates and a Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the office of the undersigned and at the office of the Secretary of the South Cambridgeshire District Council, Great Eastern House, Tenison Road, Cambridge during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposals, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 9th June 1980.

2. *(Victoria Street, Chatteris) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 198*
3. *(Victoria Street, Chatteris) (Weight Restriction) Order 198*

Notice is hereby given that the Cambridgeshire County Council propose to make Orders under sections 1 and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be:

1. With the usual exemptions for boarding and alighting, loading and unloading, disabled drivers and vehicles used in connection with public and other services' operations, to prohibit waiting at any time in the following parts of Victoria Street, Chatteris:

(a) North Side, from a point 22 metres west of its junction with East Park Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 150 metres.

(b) South Side, from a point 18 metres east of its junction with West Park Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 52 metres.

2. To vary the County of Cambridgeshire (Various Streets, Chatteris) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979 so that in the First Schedule (which covers streets subject to a prohibition of waiting at any time) the following is deleted:

"12. Victoria Street (b) from its junction with West Park Street (A141) in an easterly direction measured along the said road of 18 metres."
