

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Headlands Park, Greenbank, Plymouth) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 14th May 1980 the Devon County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on any day in the following lengths of Headland Park:

- (i) North side, from its junction with North Hill, eastwards for a distance of 43 metres (47 yards);
- (ii) South side, from its junction with North Hill, eastwards for a distance of 60 metres (66 yards).

Exceptions are provided in the Order permitting waiting for the purpose of boarding and alighting, loading and unloading, building and demolition, roadworks and the maintenance of essential services. Exceptions are also provided for disabled persons vehicles in accordance with the orange badge scheme.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the roads to which the Order relates may be inspected during normal office hours at the address given below.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 14th May 1980, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Order will come into force on 16th May 1980.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

Devon County Council (Fore Street, High Street and Castle Street, Totnes) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Experimental) Order 1980.

Notice is hereby given that on 12th May 1980 the Devon County Council made an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended.

When the Order comes into effect on 18th May 1980, you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time in the following lengths of road:

Fore Street:

- North side, from a point 12 yards west of its junction with Station Road to its junction with High Street;
- South side, from a point 220 yards west of its junction with The Plains westwards for a distance of 10 yards;
- South side, from a point 26 yards east of its junction with South Street to its junction with High Street.

High Street:

- South side, from its junction with Fore Street to opposite its junction with Castle Street;
- North side, from its junction with Fore Street to a point 99 yards west of that junction.

Castle Street: Both sides, from its junction with High Street to its junction with Antrim Terrace.

Exemptions in the Order permit waiting for the purpose of boarding and alighting, loading and unloading, Post Office services, maintenance of the road, supply of gas, water and electricity, pursuance of statutory powers or duties. The statutory exemptions for disabled persons' vehicles are included.

A copy of the Order together with a map showing the affected lengths of road may be inspected during usual office hours, Monday to Friday, at the offices of South Hams District Council, Follaton House, Plymouth Road, Totnes, or at the address given below.

If you wish to question the validity of this Order or any provision made under it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the relevant section of the Act or that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with, you may, within 6 weeks of the date of this Order, apply to the High Court for that purpose.

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Dorset (Various Roads, Corfe Castle) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Limited Waiting) Order 1980.

Notice is hereby given that on 12th May 1980 the Dorset County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

When this Order comes into effect on 16th May 1980:

(A) Waiting will be prohibited at any time on:

- (i) the eastern side of the access road to The Castle from its junction with The Square to a point 5 metres north thereof; and
- (ii) the northern side of the un-named road running westwards from the access road to The Castle for its entire length from its junction with the access road to The Castle to its junction with Oliver Vyes Lane.

(B) Waiting will be prohibited between the hours of 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. from 1st May to 15th October each year (both dates inclusive) on both sides of East Street between a point 314 metres south of its junction with the northern side of Station Road and a point 409 metres south of that junction.

(C) Waiting will be limited to 1 hour (return prohibited within 1 hour) between the hours of 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. along the entire length of the western side of The Square.

Exceptions are included in the Order to permit waiting for:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading and unloading goods;
- (c) disabled persons vehicles bearing the relevant 'orange badge';
- (d) delivering and collecting mail by Post Office vehicles; and where necessary in connection with
- (e) the maintenance of the roads;
- (f) the supply of gas, water or electricity;
- (g) any building or demolition operation or the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (h) works in connection with any telegraphic line; and
- (i) emergency service vehicles.
